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The certificate awarding and closing ceremony of 153 Foundation Training Course (FTC) was held at NAEM on 11 March 2019. Hon'ble Education Minister Dr Dipu Moni MP was present on the occasion as the chief guest. Md Sohorab Hossain, Senior Secretary, Secondary and Higher Education (SHED), Ministry of Education, and Prof Dr Syed Md. Golam Faruk, Director General, Directorate of Secondary and Higher Education (DSHE), were present in the programme as special guests to grace the ceremony. Prof Ahmed Sajjad Rashid, Director General of NAEM, presided over the ceremony and it was also attended by Prof Dr Mustafa Kamal, Director (Administration & Finance) and advisor to the 153 FTC, Prof Dr Md Lokman Hossain, Director (Training & Implementation) and convener of central examination control committee, NAEM and Nasrin Sultana, Training Specialist and course director of 153 FTC.

## Result of 153 FTC in a Nutshell

A total of 180 BCS (General Education) Cadre officers participated in 153 FTC. Among them there were 99 male participants and 80 female participants. All participants were from BCS (General Education) cadre and all of them

successfully completed the training course. Rasha Shamim, Lecturer in English of Rajshahi Govt. Women's College, stood first in the combined merit list of final evaluation and her ID number was 128. Selina Akhter, Lecturer in Political Science of Govt Eden Mohila College, Dhaka and Mohammad Sakhawat Hossain, Lecturer in Political Science, Chatkhil Panchgaon Mahbub Govt College, Noakhali, jointly stood second in the combined merit list of final evaluation and their ID numbers were 147 and 165 respectively. Abdus Salam, Lecturer in English, Govt M M College, Jessore, stood third in the combined merit list of final evaluation and his ID number was 138. Chairman Award went to Rasha Shamim, Lecturer in English, Rajshahi Govt Women's College, Rajshahi. Shayla Rafiq Lopa, Lecturer in English, Shahid Smrity Govt College, Mymensingh, was given DG's Award as all-round performer in FTC and her ID number was 160.
